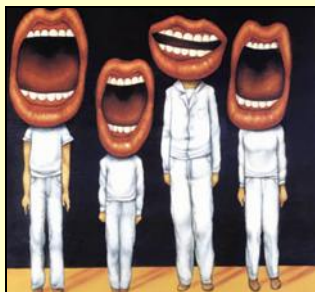

## Words on Words

We are teaching our boys how to talk. We're teaching them how to talk to one another. We're teaching them how to talk to other people. Every day, teachable moments abound. Believe me, around our house teachable moments are everywhere!



It's a full-time job to shepherd a six, four, two, and one year old through the maze of good, helpful, and God-honoring conversations. Because of their little sinful hearts, conflicts erupt quite often around our house. We feel that our responsibility is to parent them in the middle of their mini crises and to look to the future by teaching them how to have appropriate conversations with others.

It seems to me that 99.9% of our everyday situations go better when there is good communication.

Christians practice good communication. We seek to be obedient to God's word in all things—especially in the way we talk. "Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear" (Ephesians 4:29). "Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person" (Colossians 4:6). "Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity" (1 Timothy 4:12). Paul commanded Titus to practice "sound speech that cannot be condemned" (Titus 2:8).

Too often, Christians are guilty of talking about one another rather than to one another. How much easier it is to go around and talk about folks instead of talking directly to the person about whom we are "concerned." Sadly, church-going people often share their "concerns" with everyone except those with whom they are "concerned."

When non-Christians hear us talking about one another rather than to one another, no wonder they want to stay as far away from us as possible.

The Bible is crystal clear about how we are to communicate with each other. "Therefore, having put away falsehood, let each one of you speak the truth with his neighbor, for we are members one of another" (Ephesians 4:25). We don't share our "concerns" with others in an attempt to indirectly access someone. We don't play end-arounds. We deal truthfully with one another.

In Galatians 2, we read that Paul spoke directly to Peter about a concerning issue. Some might say that this is the way men talk—face to face. However, face-to-face conversation is not a man thing—it's a Christian thing.

Paul desired to conduct his ministry in a way which modeled truth and Christian communication. In 2 Corinthians 4:1-2 he said, "Therefore, having this ministry by the mercy of God, we do not lose heart. But we have renounced disgraceful, underhanded ways. We refuse to practice cunning or to tamper with God's word, but by the open statement of the truth we would commend ourselves to everyone's conscience in the sight of God."

Jesus said, "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault, between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother" (Matthew 18:15).

Brothers talk to one another. We do not talk about one another.

May the church be a people among whom good, God-honoring, face-to-face conversations take place. May the world hear the way we talk to one another, and may God be honored (Matthew 5:16)—for the good of First Baptist Church, Paducah, and beyond, and for the glory of our great God.
