We will be partnering with the church in Rivne (specifically Tolly and Polina) to reach out into the Ozero Community. (As we go, we are very mindful of Dick Thomas's heart and investment in the people of the Ukraine.)

What a team we have! Suzanne Thomas, Judy Howe and Randy Davis have served in the Ukraine before. Milly Davis, Glen Arterburn and I are joining them this year. We look forward to meeting John Wood there!

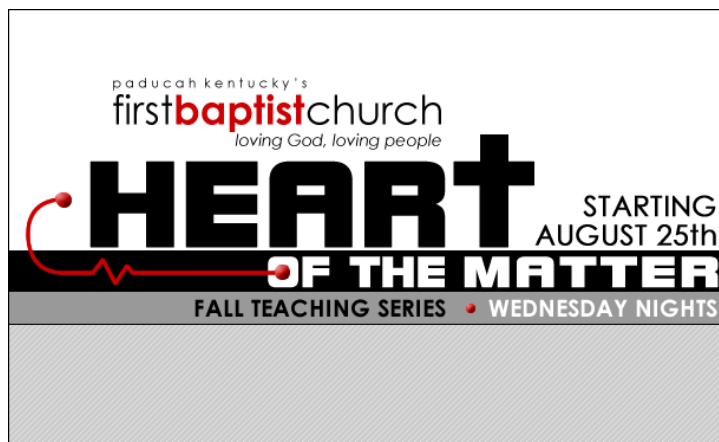
