The book of Ruth exhibits in miniature form (yet in vivid detail) the hidden (yet wise) providence of our sovereign God. It causes us to say with William Cowper,

*"God moves in a mysterious way
His wonders to perform.
He plants his footsteps in the sea
And rides upon the storm."*

The problem with footsteps planted in the sea, of course, is that they are not visible. We cannot see his every move, and so we have to acknowledge that God truly does move in "a mysterious way his wonders to perform." But thankfully, the book of Ruth teaches us that we can go on to say with William Cowper,

[God] treasures up his bright designs
And works his sovereign will....
His purposes will ripen fast
Unfolding every hour.
The bud may have a bitter taste

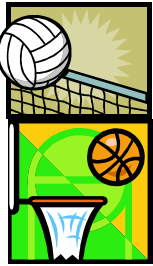
