We'd love to have you be a part of this exciting new ministry, and we'd love for those who are new coming through our doors to meet you and see your smiling faces.

One of the phrases you'll start hearing around here is, "Oh, you're new? Have you been to *Discover!* yet? You've got to experience that!"

Space for our first *Discover!* is limited. Reservations are required. As we look forward to the first class, over 70 invitations to prospective members are being sent! It's going to be great.

As we seek to reach out to others and bring them into our fellowship, the *Discover!* class is going to be a key component of our assimilation process.

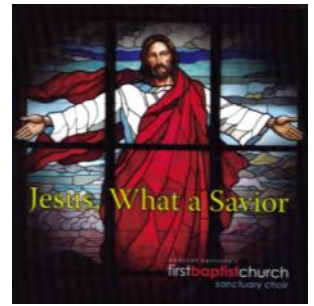
